2015.01.30.05 Discussion/Action to consider polling locations for the February 17, 2015 Special Election Run-Off.
Elections Administrator Pam Ohlendorf explained the polling locations that were special meeting approved by the Elections Committee. Commissioner Madrigal explained that this may cause confusion for the citizens that were used to voting in the usual polling locations. Commissioner Roland said that it seems very confusing for only a \$4,000.00 difference. The other Commissioners agree. It will be approximately \$4,200.00. in addition for the 10 polling locations instead of the proposed 4. Phillip Ruiz commented on the decision of the board to consolidate the polling locations. Alisha Thornton spoke on the locations and supports the decision of the board for fiscal responsibility. Motion made by Commissioner Muñoz, second by Commissioner Madrigal to leave the polling locations at the original 10 for the February 17, 2015 Special Election Run-Off. All Voting "Aye"
