

1. **WORKSHOP:** Workshop meeting with the County Judge and Commissioners following the Commissioners Court meeting on February 25, 2019 will be held. The purpose of the meeting is to present an overview of the TX General Land Office Community Development Block Grant Disaster Recovery Program (CDBG-DR) grant (“Buyout / Acquisition” and “Local Infrastructure”) programs and to share some recommendations on the possible use of those funds.

Court members, Dennis Engelke, Judy Langford, and Tracy Bratton discuss the Grant, including potential uses for the funds and scheduling a second workshop on March 11th where Commissioners will each provide their top five choices for the funds’ use.


Commissioner Theriot and Judy Langford discuss a federal funding option for private roads, but such funds are only available to Counties closer to the Texas/Mexico border.
