**2015.11.04.03 Discussion/Action** to continue the Local Disaster Declaration ordered by the Caldwell County Judge pursuant to Section 418.108 of the Texas Local Government Code on or about October 30, 2015, related to flooding and inclement weather in Caldwell County. **Cost: None Speaker: Judge Schawe Backup 1.**

Martin Richey gave a presentation of past weather conditions and its affects within the county. The county received approximately 10" of rainfall over the Halloween weekend. Volunteers will be available to help those affected by the flooding to clean up their homes this Saturday and Sunday, November 7<sup>th</sup> and 8<sup>th</sup> at the Martindale Baptist Church, 12351 HWY 142 from 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tetanus and influenza vaccinations will also be given at the Church from 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. No charge for those services. Judge Schawe asked for an update on the upcoming weather conditions. Martin Richey stated the county is not within the area of heavy precipitation and is estimated to receive 1 to 2 inches of rainfall. He said the conditions will still be monitored closely.
