Elections administrator Vicky Gonzales stated she had looked at the Interlocal Government Agreement and that some procedures, especially during early voting, will be changed from the stated Agreement. Assistant District Attorney Ron Heggemeier suggested that Vicky and the City of Lockhart write down the changes needed to the Agreement. Motion made by Commissioner Cyrier, seconded by Commissioner Madrigal, to table this item until July 12, 2010. Motion carried unanimously.
