#### 08.27.07 County Administrator Report/Presentation.

A. Septic and Subdivision Fees Report.

Report was presented by County Administrator Ron Heggemeier. He reported that although the August revenues were down, the totals were still \$6,610.00 above the budgeted amount.

#### 08.27.08 Special Presentations.

A. Up-date on San Marcos River Safety over the Labor Day Weekend due to a directive from Sheriff Law not to use county assets (radios) for river safety communication given by Constable Zapata.

Constable Zapata reports that 122 tickets were given out on the river over Labor Day Weekend. Constables from Precinct 1 & 4 and the County Deputies worked together. Commissioner Madrigal said that he had observed the difference in the behavior when the County Deputies were present. He said that a few of the neighbors from Spring River Estates had also commented that they felt there had been a difference. Chief Deputy, David Brent agreed with Constable Zapata that it had been a miscommunication about the radios.

B. Up-date on training for Commercial Vehicle Enforcement Service given by Constable Zapata.

Constable Zapata reported that he and Constable Pct. 4 Art Villareal have completed class in Austin and are now ready to train with the DPS Officers. He reports that the scales that Caldwell County has purchased have been received. Commissioner Cyrier thanks him for being pro-active for our County.
