



ORDER 06-2026
AUTHORIZING JUNETEENTH FIREWORKS SALES


WHEREAS, the Commissioners Court of Caldwell County is authorized under Occupations Code Section 2154.202(h), to issue an order allowing retail fireworks permit holders to sell fireworks to the public in celebration of Juneteenth; and

WHEREAS, on the 14th day of May, 2026, the Commissioners Court of Caldwell County has determined that conditions are favorable to issue such an Order;


NOW, THEREFORE, the Commissioners Court of Caldwell County adopts this Order authorizing the sale of fireworks to the public by retail fireworks permit holders during the Juneteenth period beginning June 14, 2026 and ending at midnight June 19, 2026, subject to the following restrictions:

- a. This order expires on the date the Texas A&M Forest Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, June 19, 2026, whichever is earlier.
- b. The sale of restricted fireworks as defined by Section 352.051, Texas Local Government Code, including “skyrockets with sticks” and “missiles with fins,” is prohibited.
