As per Governor Abbott's Executive Proclamation amending paragraph numbers 5 and 12 of Executive Order GA-28, effective at 12:01 p.m. on July 3, 2020, for any outdoor gathering in the unincorporated area of the county in excess of 10 people, other than those exempted in GA-28, is prohibited unless the county judge approves of the gathering and such approval can be made subject to certain condition or restrictions not inconsistent with GA-28.
