



RESOLUTION 38-2022

RESOLUTION OF CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT

AMENDING ORDER AUTHORIZING INDEPENDENCE DAY FIREWORKS SALES

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2022, the Caldwell County Commissioners Court issued an order authorizing the sale of fireworks for the Fourth of July holiday period beginning June 24, 2022, through midnight July 4, 2022 (“the Holiday period”);

WHEREAS, on June 14, 2022, the Commissioners Court determined that favorable conditions existed to issue its Order, in that drought conditions existed in Caldwell County;

WHEREAS, in its June 14, 2022, Order, the Commissioners Court prohibited the sale of fireworks utilizing “sticks and fins” during the Holiday period;

WHEREAS, the June 14, 2022, Order—including the prohibition on “sticks and fins”—expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county during the Holiday period or midnight, July 4, 2022, whichever is earlier; and

WHEREAS the Commissioners Court continues to desire the sale prohibition of fireworks utilizing “sticks and fins.”

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CALDWELL COUNTY COMMISSIONERS COURT THAT the Commissioners Court’s prior June 14, 2022, Order is hereby amended to strike the following language:

b. “This order expires on the date the Texas Fire Service determines drought conditions exist in the county or midnight, July 4, 2022, whichever is earlier.”
